Guidelines effective 1 July 2005

**Guidelines for application of credit form**

1. Monthly accounts will be paid in full within fourteen (14) days from the date of the account.
2. In the event that any charges appearing on the statement are disputed by the applicant, notice of such dispute must be conveyed to council in writing by the due date of the account.
3. Where accounts are overdue:
  - a) A services fee of 1.5% monthly will be incurred;
  - b) Credit will not be available until all arrears are paid in full.
4. Council reserves the right to suspend/cancel this credit facility at any time.
5. Council reserves the right to charge pro rata all account holders, during periods of non operation of the weighbridge. The pro rata charge will be levied according to the previous monthly account.
6. Agreement that Darwin City Council may seek consumer credit information (Section 18K(1)(b), Privacy Act 1988) If Darwin City Council considers it relevant to assessing my/our application for commercial credit, I/we agree to Darwin City Council obtaining from a credit reporting agency a credit report containing personal credit information about me/us in relation to commercial credit provided by Darwin City Council.
7. Exchanging information with other credit providers (Section 18N(1)(b), Privacy Act 1988) I/we agree to Darwin City Council obtaining personal information about me/us from other credit providers, whose names I/we may have provided for Darwin City Council or that may be named in a credit report, for the purpose of assessing my/our application for commercial credit made to Darwin City Council.
8. Agreement to a credit provider being given a consumer credit report to collect overdue payments on commercial credit (Section 18K 1(h) Privacy Act 1988) I/we agree that Darwin City Council may obtain a consumer credit report about me/us from a credit reporting agency for the purpose of collecting overdue payments relating to commercial credit owed by me/us.
