## Casuarina Library Business as Usual

The Casuarina Library is up and running again after experiencing problems with an air-conditioning unit. Darwin City Council acted immediately and contractors identified and fixed the problem. The air-conditioning unit is now functioning correctly and full operations of Casuarina Library have resumed.

Darwin City Council CEO, Mr Brendan Dowd said that the community had been very understanding and patient during the last few days.

“Darwin people have a good understanding of issues such as air-conditioning units experiencing problems now and then. They’re also appreciative of us working so quickly to bring services back as soon as we can,” he said.

Mr Dowd said he was grateful, not only to the Darwin Community, but also to Library Staff who went out of their way to make sure the Library could be operational on Thursday.

“People have been very patient and supportive of our staff at the Casuarina Library who volunteered to work during the warmer conditions on yesterday”.

The Casuarina Library was closed at the end of last year for a major refit. The new Casuarina Library is an improved recourse for the community. It is free to join and residents can read and borrow books, CDs, DVDs and other materials, as well as research online or surf the internet.
