When a burn occurs, it is human instinct to attempt to treat the victim immediately. Follow these safety tips on first aid:

## REMOVE

Person safely from heat source

## REMOVE

Clothing to help heat escape. If clothes are stuck to the skin leave them on

## COOL IT

Immediately submerge or gently pour cold tap water over the scald for at least 10-15 minutes. Eg stand in shower. NEVER USE ICE, OIL, BUTTER OR OINTMENT.

## COVER IT

with cling wrap. Keep the person warm.

## GET HELP

Seek medical attention for all burns. A burn larger than a postage stamp requires medical attention. All deep burns of any size require urgent hospital treatment.
